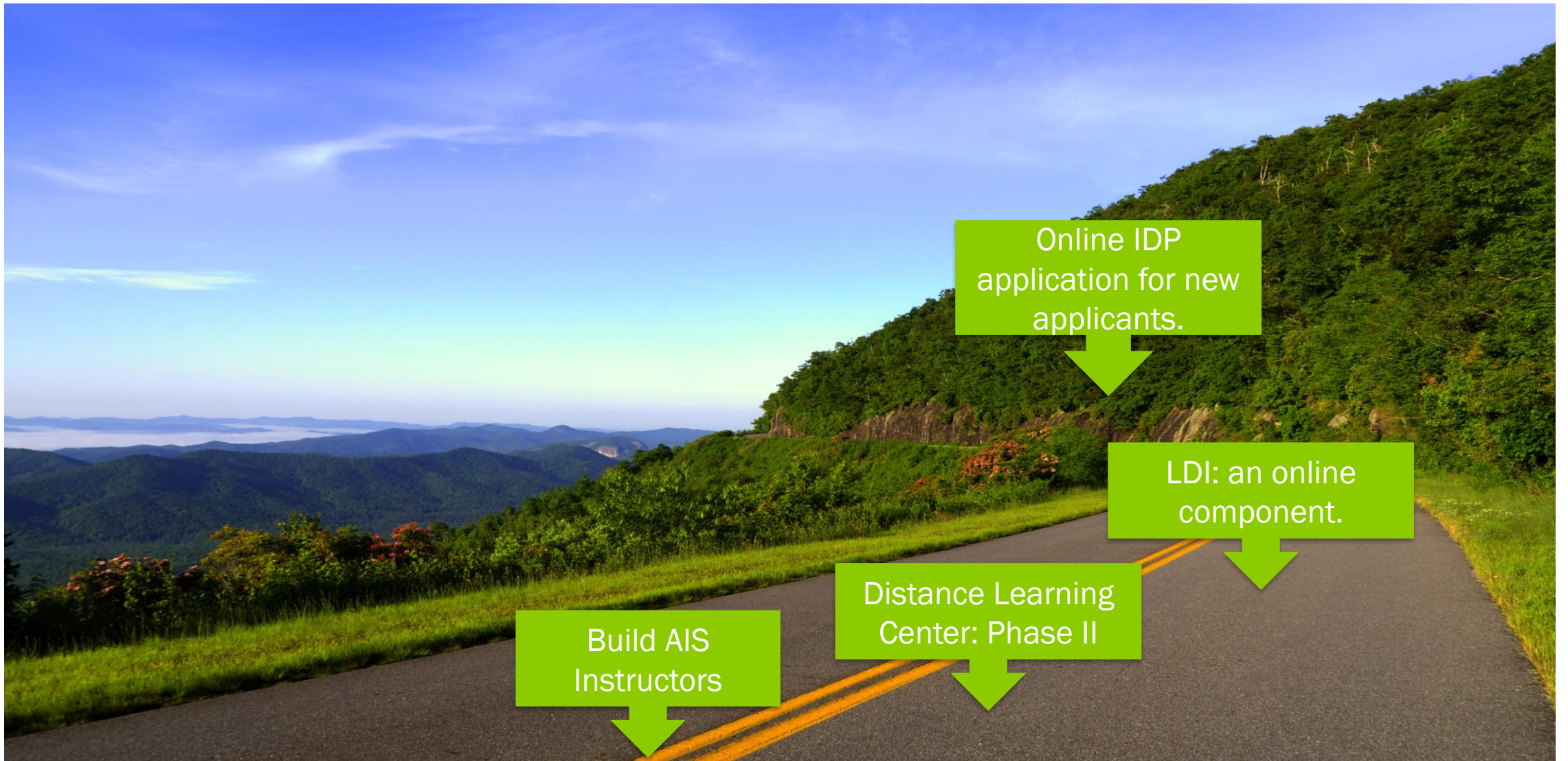



IDP Maintenance

The APICS IDP is dedicated to the ongoing elevation of the skills and performance of all APICS Recognized Instructors to maintain and enhance their learners' experience.

IDP Maintenance Resources

APICS Recognized Instructors (IDP instructors) are required to maintain their instructional skills, body of knowledge credentials, membership and requisite affiliations during the 5-year maintenance cycle period.

The first cycle begins January 1, 2018. The IDP Maintenance application fee is USD \$75. Below is an overview of the maintenance requirements.

CPIM Timeline for IDP Maintenance

If your maintenance year is:

2018 - 2020

If your maintenance year is:

2021

Associate Instruct or co-instruct **1** entire exam course – legacy or new.

Associate Instruct or co-instruct **1** entire new exam course – either Part 1 or Part 2.

Lead In the previous 5 years, instruct:
 1. any **3** legacy exam courses
 2. or both new exam courses; or
 3. any combination of #1 and #2

Lead Instruct **both new exam courses at least 1 time** during 5-year maintenance cycle (2017-2021)

Master In the previous 5 years, instruct: **either complete program - legacy or new.**

Master Instruct **both new exam courses at least 2 times** during the 5-year maintenance cycle (2017-2021)

CPIM Timeline for New IDP Applicants and Designation Upgrades

If you apply or upgrade in
2017-18

If you apply or upgrade in 2019

Associate Instruct or co-instruct **1** entire exam course – legacy or new.

Associate Instruct or co-instruct **1** entire new exam course (either Part 1 or Part 2).

Lead In the previous 5 years instruct:
1.any 3 legacy exam courses;
2.or co-instruct both **new** exam courses; or
3.any combination of #1 and #2

Lead Instruct **both new exam courses at least 1 time** (Parts 1 and 2)

Master In the previous 5 years, instruct:
either complete program – legacy or new.

Master Instruct **both new exam courses at least 2 times** (Parts 1 and 2)
